STATION DESIGN ISSUES

- Lack of signage
- No connection between platforms
- No facilities
- No park & Ride
- Platform too low
- Information incorrect
- Limited bike storage
- Poor waiting room
- Lack of identity
- No visible bins



STATION DESIGN SOLUTIONS

- New footbridge with lifts and stairs
- Build a kiosk with public facilities
- Build shelters with seats
- Ticket machine need to be more visible
- New high-level platform built
- Drop-off zone, and a few parking spaces
- A plaque/ signs talking about the history of the station/area

ENVIRONMENTAL ISSUES

Issues:

- Recycling bins
- Noise pollution
- Keeping the platform clean
- No sustainable power source
- Environmental friendly waiting area
- Speed of train

Solutions:

- More visible recycling bins
- Sound barriers should be improved
- A rota should be implemented by Kiosk
- Solar panels to power the station
- TV information boards
- Kiosk
- Speed limit for trains within the area

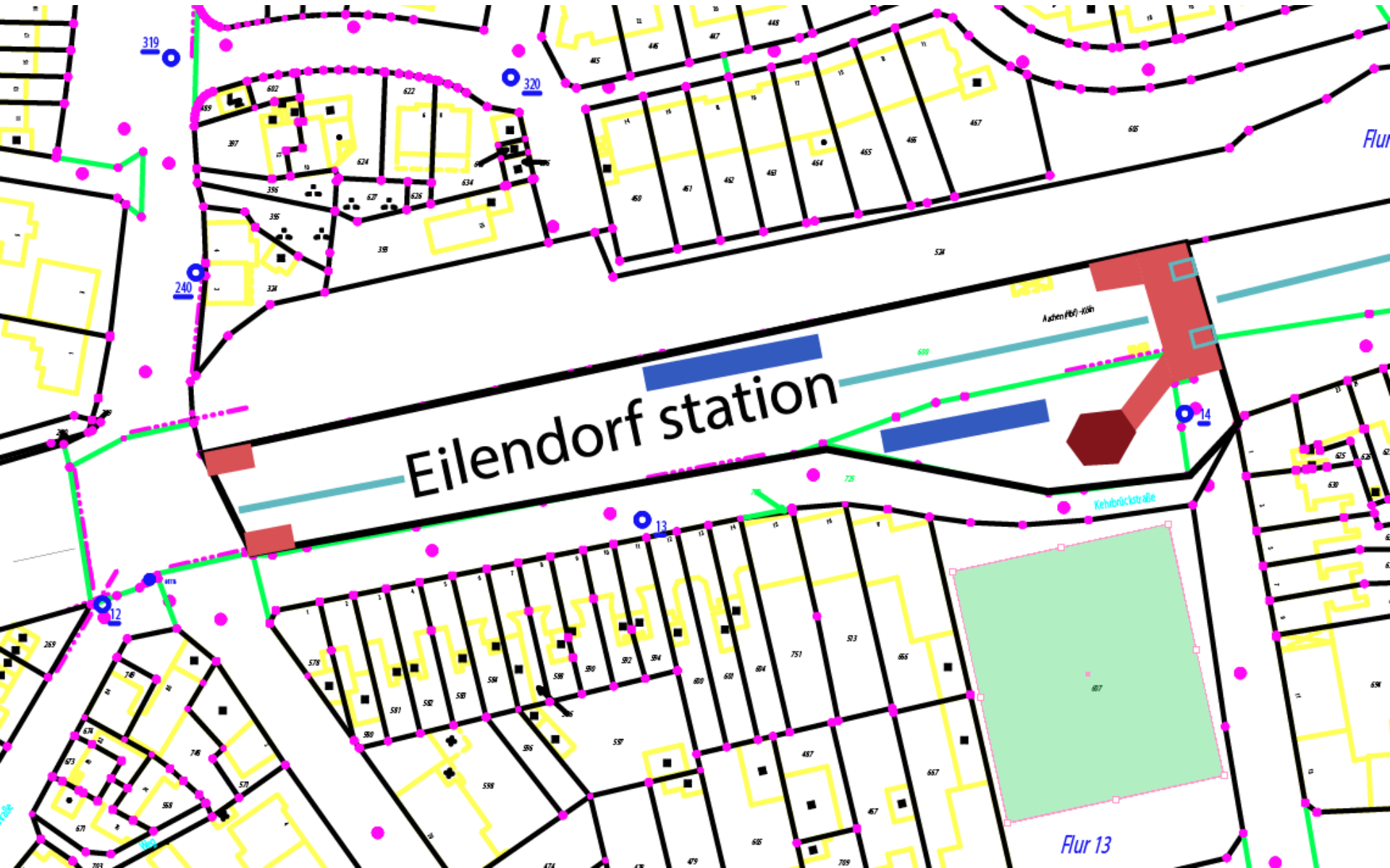
