





For just £10, a Devon Day Ranger gives you unlimited travel within Devon (including on The Riviera Line) for the day. Valid after 09:00 Mon-Fri, and any time at weekends. If you are travelling after 18:00, a Devon Evening Ranger costs just £5.

CHILDREN'S DISCOUNTS

Under 5 year-olds travel free, 5-15 year-olds half price.

1/3 OFF FOR GROUPS

Groups of 3 to 9 people get a third off with a GroupSave ticket on off peak First Great Western trains. Buy from station ticket offices, or from the guard if departing from an unstaffed station.




